Your Challenge

To bring to the RYPEN CAMP a backpack containing the following items: -

General Item	Toiletries	Food items
Backpack	Toothbrush	Biscuits
Scarf – Male/Female	Toothpaste	Cup a soup
Umbrella	Soap in a box	Tea sachets
Poncho (Plastic)	Flannel	Coffee Sachets
Beanie	Hand Towel	Pasta Cup
Socks – Male/Female	Tissues small pack	Noodle Cup
Thermos Mug	Deodorant – Male/Female	Sugar sachets
Thermos Food	Sanitary products	
Plastic ground sheet – this can be painting sheet from Bunnings	Hand sanitiser small bottle	

These items can be second hand if in good condition. These items do not need to be expensive and can be found at K Mart, Big W, Best and Less etc. It is important that each backpack is identical and marked either MALE or FEMALE

Please look to friends and family to support, talk to your year coordinators to see if you can run a non-uniform day to raise money for the goods. Perhaps if you are a budding chef you could make cupcakes to sell to your fellow students.
